

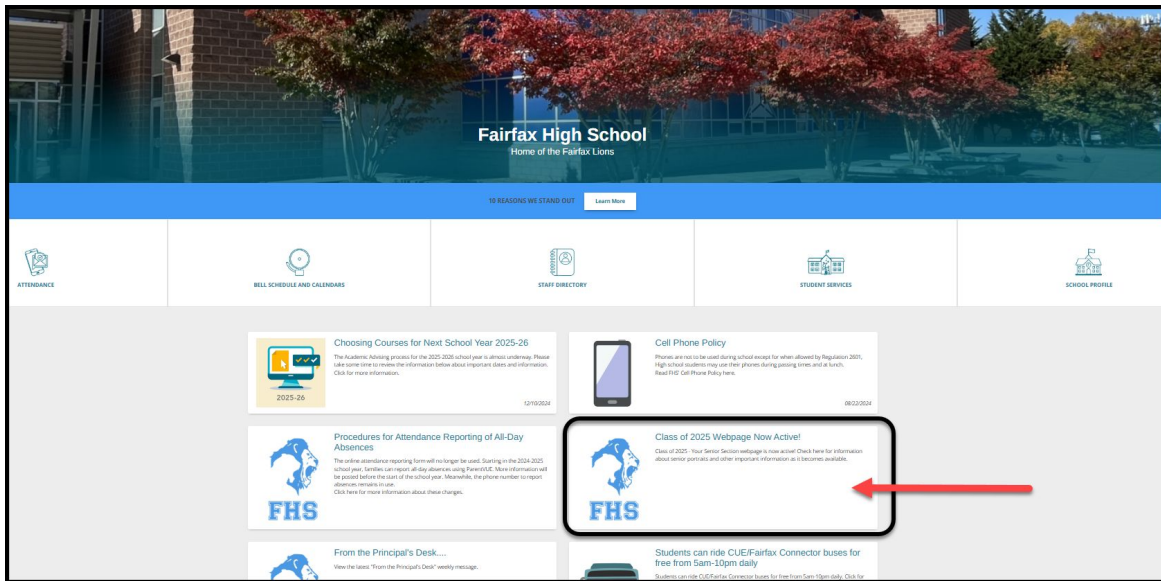

# Senior Dues - Process

## SENIOR Dues Online Payment Directions-**NOT FOR STUDENTS RECEIVING FREE OR REDUCED BENEFITS**

- Go to **www.myschoolbucks.com** from a computer
- Login into your account **or** create an account
- Go to the **SCHOOL STORE**
- **BROWSE ALL ITEMS**
- If your family has multiple students at different locations you may have to **FILTER BY SCHOOL**, located in the upper left-hand corner of the screen, the choose **FAIRFAX HS.**
- Look for this icon (you may have to go through multiple pages)



- Click view details
- Choose your student name from the drop down
- Add payment to the cart
- Start the checkout process.

# Cap & Gown

- Included in your Senior Dues
- You'll receive them before graduation closer to the day.
- Students must have all dues and fines resolved to receive your cap and gown
- or copy of your diploma



# Graduation Attire

- **Same color gowns and caps for all students**
- **Cap decorating is permitted**
  - Clear guidelines will be provided.
  - Caps are subject to be reviewed and could be replaced.
- **Flat or wedge heels footwear**
  - High heels are not permitted due to their impact on the stadium turf

- **There would be a 24 hr notice**




# All Night Grad Party
