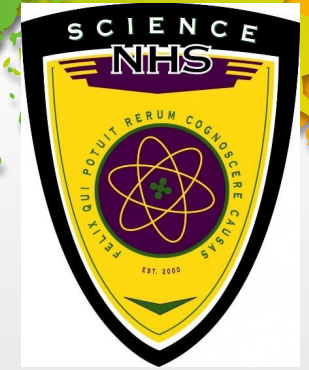

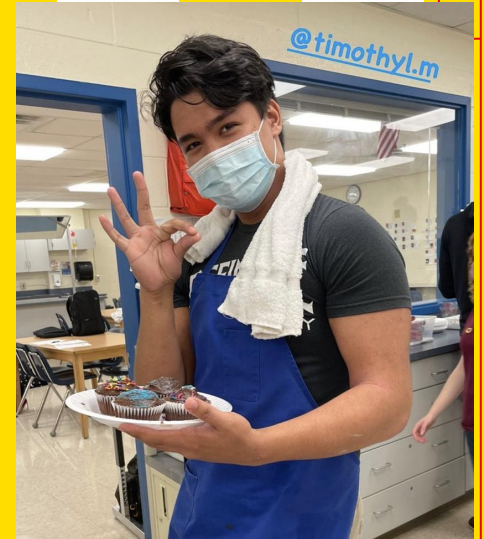

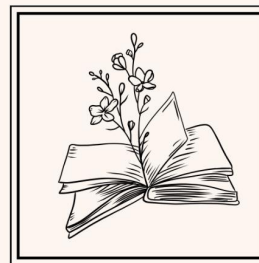


CREATIVE WRITING CLUB
