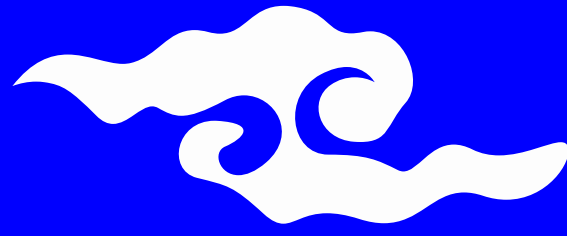
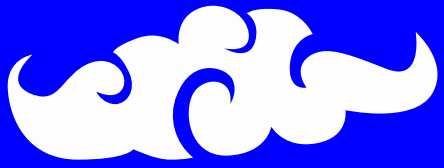


MEDLIFE - FAIRFAX

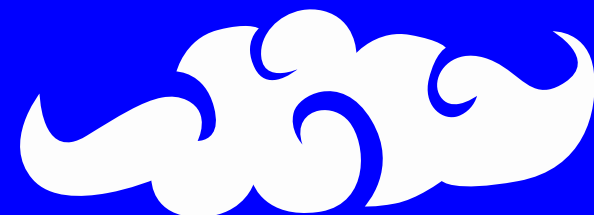
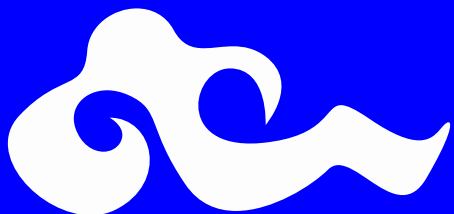

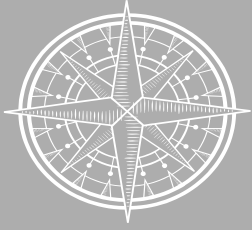
